(2) In this application following reliefs have been sought to be granted:

(i) To direct the respondents to consider the representations dated 02.02.2017, 28.03.2017 and 12.10.2017 of the applicant and grant family pension to her being unmarried daughter of a deceased soldier with up-to-date arrears; and

(ii) To pass such other or further orders as deemed fit under the given facts and circumstances of the case.

(3) It has been noticed in the order passed on the previous date that PPO stood issued in this matter and perhaps it is for this reason that neither the applicant nor learned counsel representing her has put in appearance.

(4) We are satisfied that on issuance of the PPO the applicant is no more interested to pursue this application any further. Being so, the same is dismissed for want of prosecution.
