	(CWJC No. 14107/2006) and subsequently registered and renumbered in this
	Tribunal as TA No. 40/2011.
	We find from records that neither the applicant nor any counsel on his
	behalf who represented him in the Hon'ble Patna High Court was ever present
	before this Tribunal to represent the applicant since 13.05.2011 when the matter
	came up in the cause list. Thereafter one Mr. Ashok Kumar Ghosh, Advocate,
	did appear for the applicant in the chamber of the Hon'ble Member (Judicial) on
	04.07.2011 and he undertook to file his vokalatnama for the applicant on the next
	date. He again appeared before the constituted Bench on 04.08.2011 and sought
	for time to file such vokalatnama. Thereafter the matter appeared again on

appeared to represent the applicant in the matter. Even, Mr. Ghosh who made a few appearances in the year 2011, stopped appearing since, perhaps, despite his efforts he could not obtain necessary powers from the applicant.

06.09.2011 and 15.11.2011 before the Bench and on all such occasions, Mr. Ghosh continued praying for time to file vokalatnama but he could not file any such vokalatnama.
